1. Subject Expert Librarians

2. Teaching & Learning

3. Course Resource Lists

Leddy Library's Course Resource List system allows you to create digital reading lists for your Blackboard course site that connect to the Library's online and print resources as well as content anywhere on the web. The Library also provides support with digitization and copyright clearance for your resources.

4. Academic Data Centre

The Leddy Library's Academic Data Centre can help you find open and restricted datasets, interpret statistical methods and procedures, create graphs and maps, and manage your research data efficiently.

5. Scholarly Communication

The Leddy Library can support you throughout the research lifecycle. This includes information discovery, research data management and archiving, providing open access to publications, and measuring impact.

6. Digital Scholarship

The Library's Centre for Digital Scholarship supports faculty who want to create digital publishing projects, develop digital archives, and other emerging digital services.

7. Copyright Compliance

The Leddy Library provides guidance and resources on campus copyright policy, including fair dealing. We're here to help you manage copyright in the classroom and your research.

8. Research Data Management

Learn to work efficiently with your research data and to meet funding agency requirements. The Leddy Library's Academic Data Centre can help you develop a plan to manage your data, learn about data analysis, storing and sharing.

9. Archives & Special Collections

Our digital and physical collections provide faculty and students with hands-on access to the region's history.

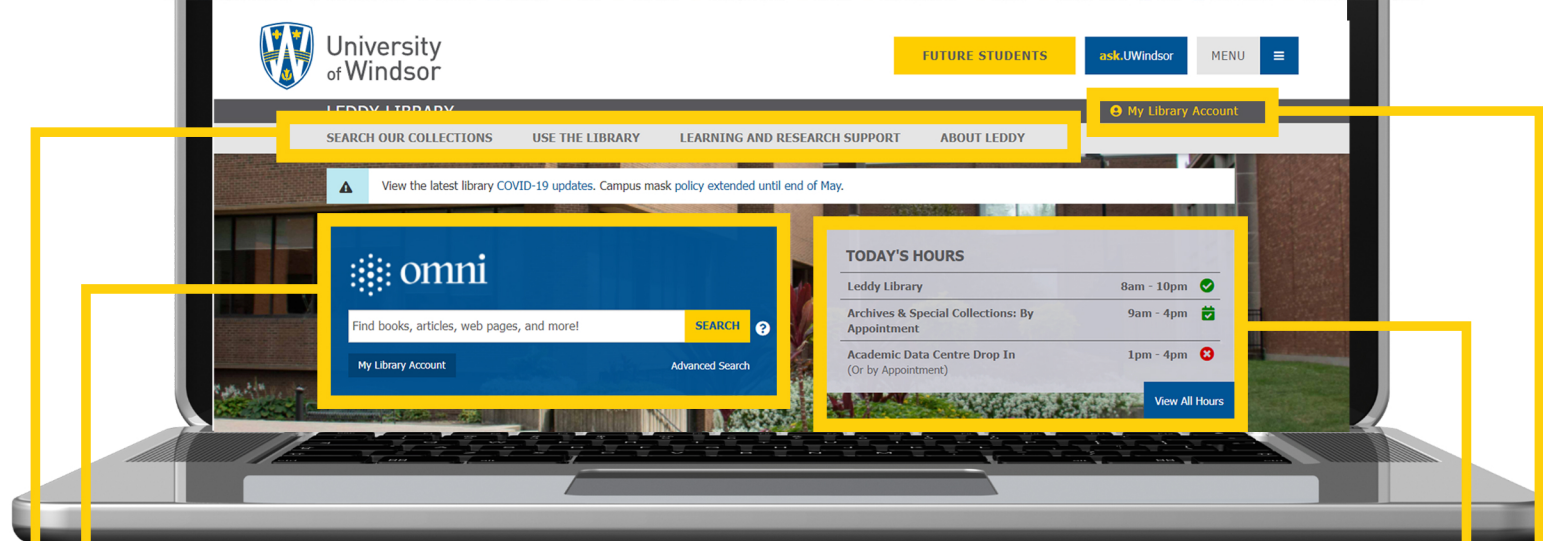
